Please read the following closely and you'll be amazed at what now can be recycled and how easy it is by just creating a new habit. City of Sully Ordinance states all solid waste and recycling should be placed on the curb by 6:00 a.m. To insure collection, please set out the evening prior or by 6:00 a.m. Thank You

These items are accepted through curbside and recycling center programs.

1. PAPER—all paper is now accepted.
 - a. Newspaper
 - b. Newspaper inserts
 - c. Magazines
 - d. Junk Mail
 - e. Flattened paperboard—example—cereal, cracker, soap type boxes, etc.
 - f. School paper
 - g. Moving paper
 - h. Shredded paper—bagged.
 - i. Phone books
2. Corrugated Cardboard—flattened Only
3. Plastic
 - a. #1 thru #7—food and hygiene products bottles and containers—rinsed
 - b. Redemption bottles
4. Tin/Aluminum
 - a. Food cans--rinsed
 - b. Pet food cans--rinsed
 - c. Aluminum foil
 - d. Redemption aluminum cans
 - e. Aluminum cans
5. Glass
 - a. Clear—food and hygiene bottles and jars—rinsed

Accepted at Recycling Center **ONLY**—Books—must be boxed or bagged for easy handling—

Non-accepted items thru recycling program—window glass, ceramic, cookware, blue glass, light bulbs, plates, drinking glasses, Styrofoam, plastic wrap, extra grocery bags, plastic toys, and rubber hoses. These items are accepted in your regular household trash.
